- 5= Volunteered consistently for 4 or more organizations (or) 4 years with 1 organization
- 4= Volunteered consistently for 3 organizations (or) 3 years with 1 organization
- 3= Volunteered consistently for 2 organizations (or) 2 years with 1 organization
- 2= Volunteered consistently for 1 organization for at least 1 year
- 1= Volunteered consistently for 1 or more organizations on a short-term basis
- 0= No community service

Scoring Options: 0 - 5

Employment - Internship*

Ability to balance work and/or an internship with academic achievement and community service.

- 3= Work experience with one employer for more than one year AND internship experience
- 2= Work experience for less than one year AND internship experience
- 1= Work experience OR internship experience
- 0= No work or internship experience

Essay*

The reviewer may deduct points if the applicant did not follow directions. This includes using identifying information, such as names, in your essay.

Excellent (10-9):

- Well written and very organized
- Excellent grammar mechanics and concise statements
- Excellent effort and presentation with detail
- Demonstrates a thorough understanding of the topic
- The essay is compelling to the reader
- All parts of the questions are addressed

Good (8-7):

- Writes fairly clearly
- Good grammar mechanics
- Good presentation and organization
- Sufficient effort and detail

Fair (6-5):

- Minimal effort
- Fair grammar mechanics
- Fair presentation
- Few supporting details

Poor (4-3):

- Somewhat unclear
- Shows little effort
- Poor grammar mechanics
- Confusing and choppy
- Incomplete sentences
- No organized thoughts

Very poor (2-0):

- Lack of effort
- Very poor grammar mechanics
- Very unclear
- The essay does not address the questions/topic
- Lack of attempt
